WELCOME TO QUINTA DA RIA

CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF COURSE

Situated in the Eastern side of the Algarve, also known as the Sotavento Algarvio, Quinta da Ria includes two spectacular golf courses, Quinta da Ria and Quinta de Cima, a 9-hole pitch-and-putt academy course, and a state-of-the-art practice facility.

Located just over half an hour from Faro International Airport, Quinta da Ria is perfectly integrated in the Ria Formosa Nature Reserve, the most significant Eco-system in the Algarve, comprised of a line of barrier Islands along the coast, making this protected wet land a rich nature habitat for numerous biological species.



QUINTA DE CIMA CHAMPIONSHIP

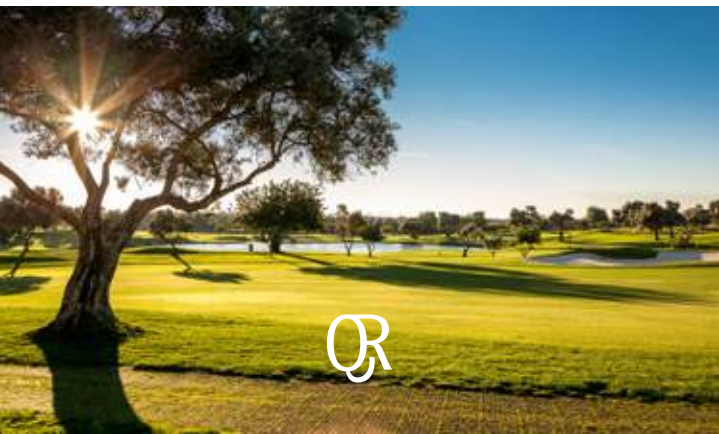
Designed by the renowned American Architect - Rocky Roquemore, Quinta de Cima was conceived as the championship course of the golf resort.

The course, which opened in 2002, has featured some important Professional Tournaments:

- PGA Europro Tour in 2003 and 2004
- European Tour Seniors Portugal Open in 2005
- European Seniors Tour Qualifying School in 2006, 2007 and 2008
- Ladies European Tour Portuguese Open in 2008

The course is characterized by its ancient carob and olive trees, but also by its undulating greens which are well protected by large sandy bunkers and lakes.

You will be surprised by how many players prefer this course to the seaside Quinta da Ria course. Have fun!



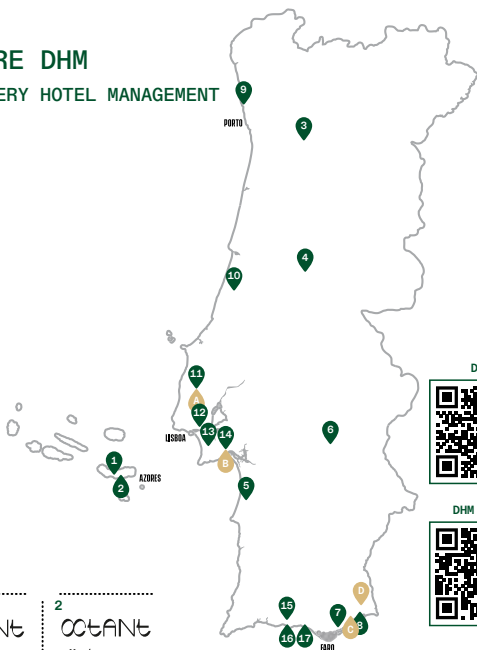

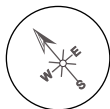

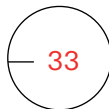
Compass point shows orientation of hole



Indicates green slopes, with condensed lines being the most severe



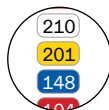
Direction to the next hole



These figures indicate depth of green from front edge 'o'



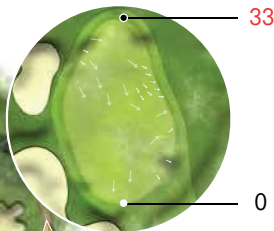
Numbers below the hole number indicate PAR and Stroke Index

Good opening hole. Drive short or aggressively between fairway bunkers. Second shot towards righthand bunker, leaving a good access (short iron approach) to the green bunkered left front.

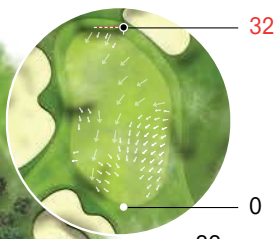
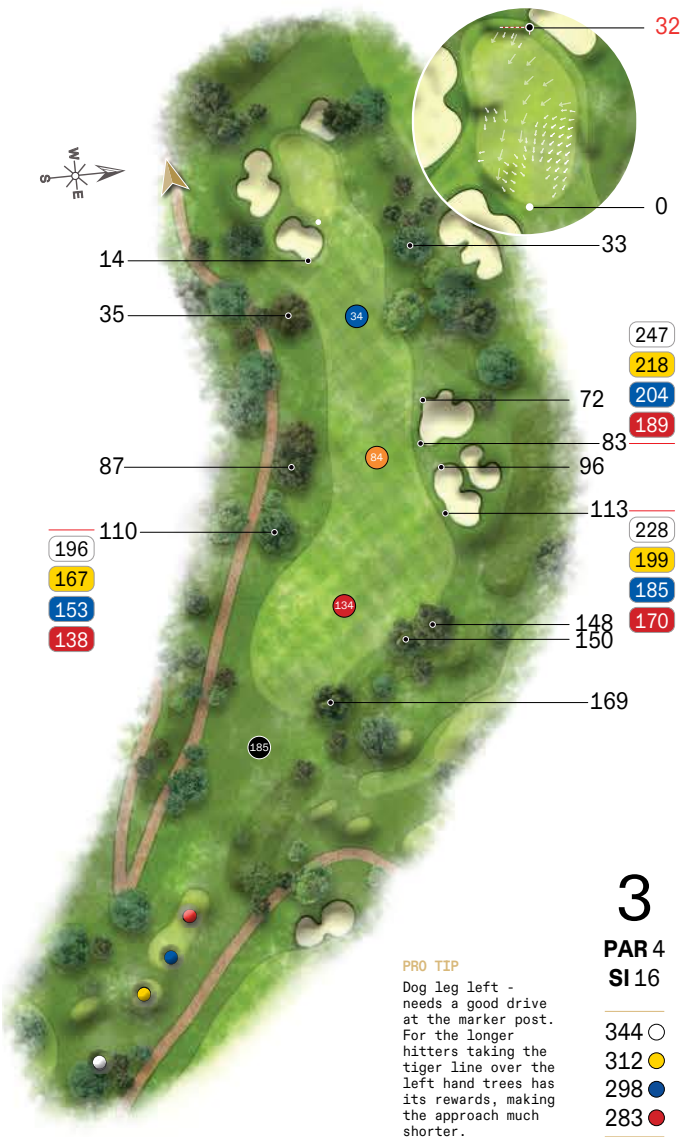

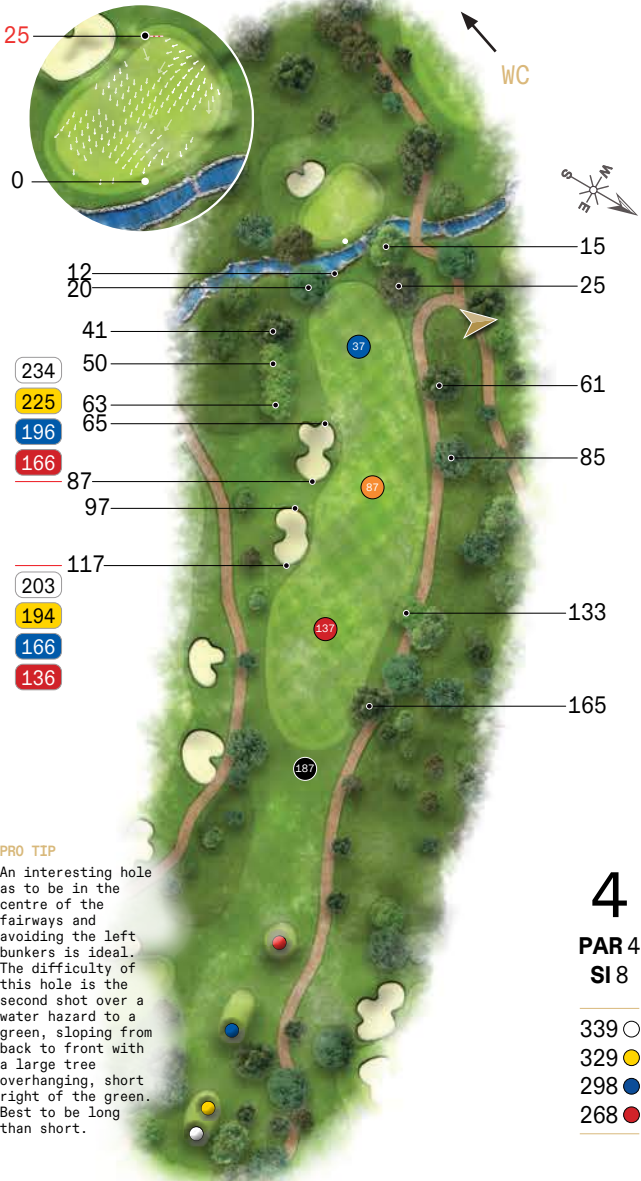
Dog leg left - needs a good drive at the marker post. For the longer hitters taking the tiger line over the left hand trees has its rewards, making the approach much shorter.

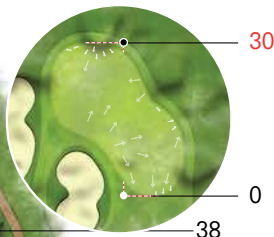

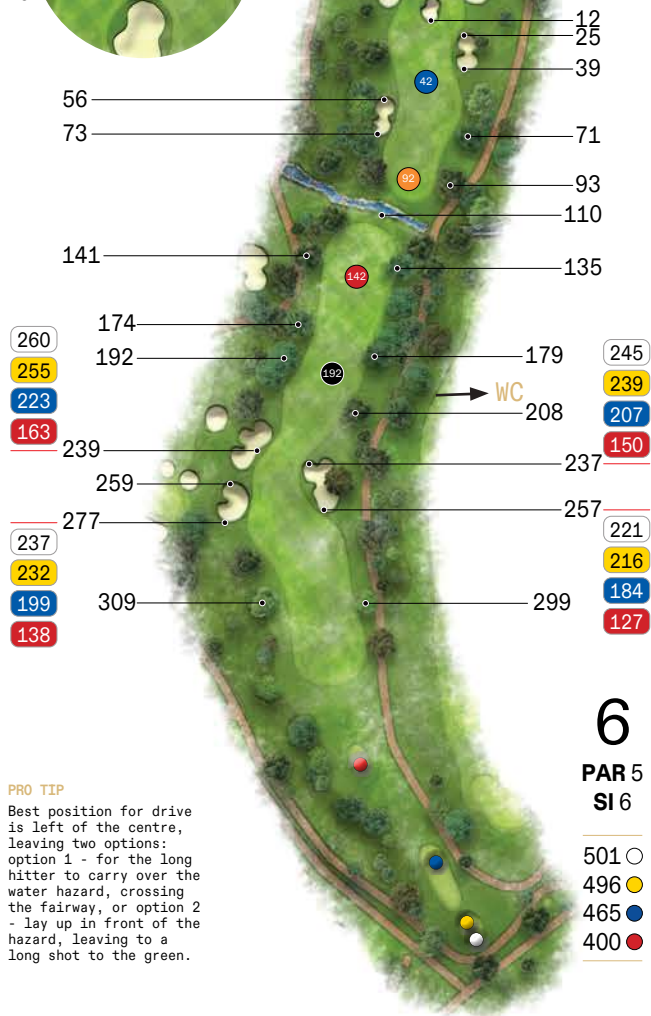
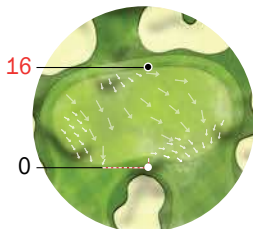
PRO TIP

Keeping the drive right of the fairway, avoiding the left hand bunkers and a right-hand tree, is a must as the second shot needs to be accurate to carry the bunkers in front of the green.

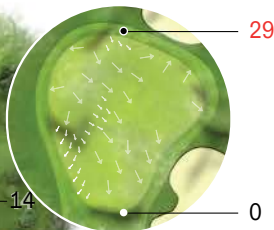

PRO TIP

Best position for drive is left of the centre, leaving two options:
 option 1 - for the long hitter to carry over the water hazard, crossing the fairway, or option 2 - lay up in front of the hazard, leaving to a long shot to the green.



PRO TIP

Straight hole slightly uphill, needing a good drive with a long second to the green, avoiding front right bunker.

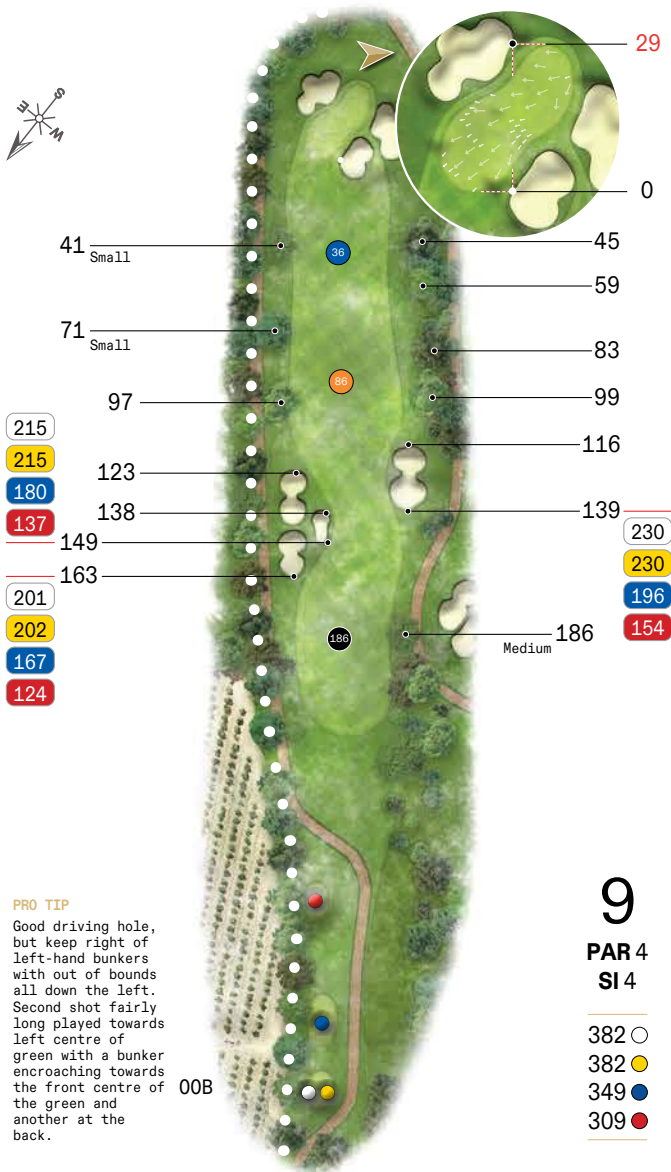
Long par 3 usually playing all its length with bunkers and trees, guarding either side of a long narrow green. Middle Wood or long iron is required.

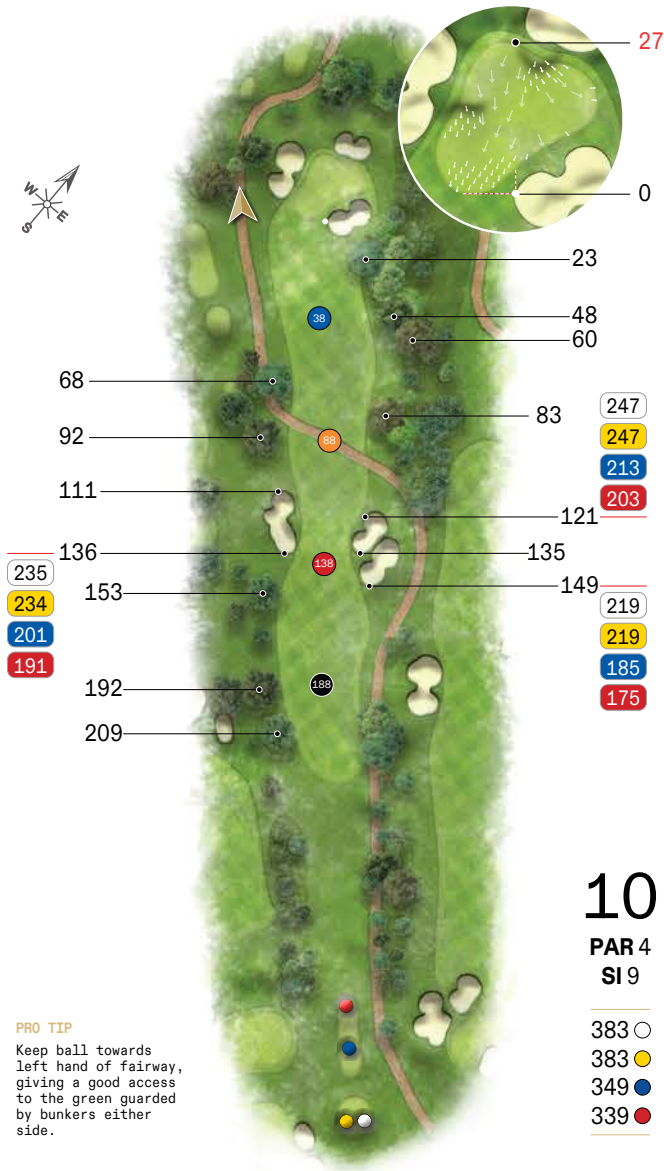
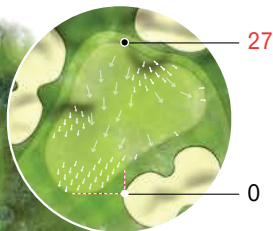
PRO TIP

Good driving hole, but keep right of left-hand bunkers with out of bounds all down the left. Second shot fairly long played towards left centre of green with a bunker encroaching towards the front centre of the green and another at the back.

Deceiving short hole with a dip in front of the green, giving you a false impression of its length by looking shorter than it really is and well guarded by bunkers. Accuracy is a must!

Out of bounds either side of the fairway, large bunkers in the centre of the fairway however they should be out of reach.

Second shot aimed at the left centre of the green avoiding large bunker right front of the green. Beware of out of bounds behind the green.

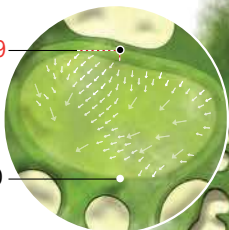

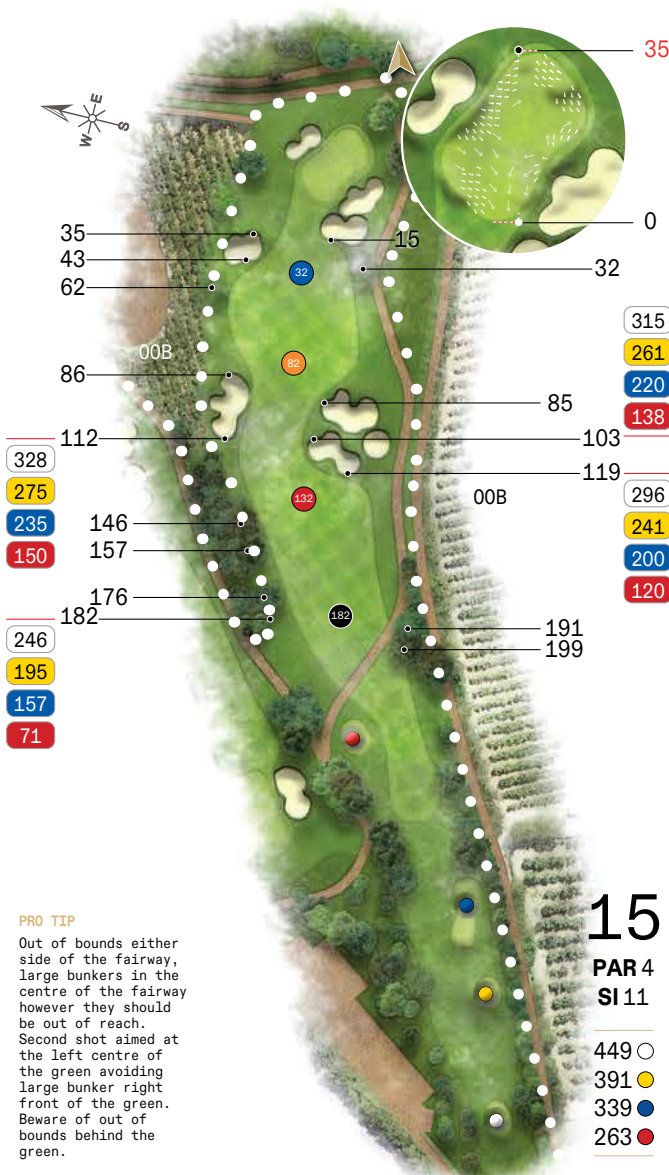

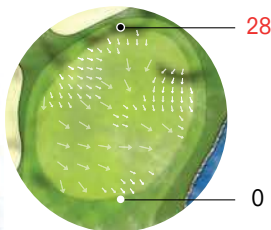

A difficult finishing hole with a demanding drive over a water hazard with a large lake on the right all the way down to the green.

Once over the water hazard you are left with a choice of going for the green by taking the lake on, or bail out left of the green but will leave you with a tricky chip to the green.
